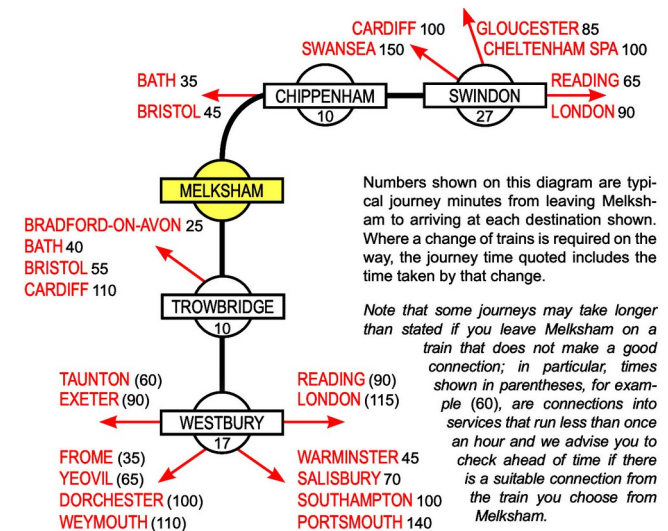

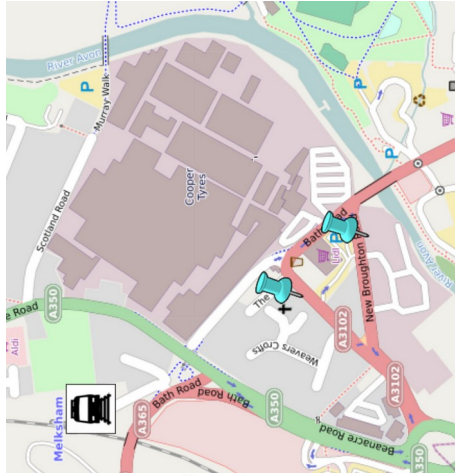

Travelling from & to the station in Melksham
 You can walk or cycle to the station, get a lift there or drive yourself. The station is less than 10 minutes walk (signposted) from the Town Bridge – postcode SN12 8BN

Free 20 minute pick up and drop off spaces are available at the station, with longer term paid parking available just across Station Approach. There is covered cycle parking at the station, and a shelter while you wait for your train, but no public toilet. There are toilets on all trains that call at Melksham. Cycles may be taken on trains. All trains and all five stations on the line are wheelchair accessible.

Buses do not currently serve Melksham Station but all local bus services call at the stops on Old Broughton Road (towards Bowerhill, Semington and Devizes) or New Broughton Road (toward Holt, Whitley, Corsham and Lacock) which are a five minute walk from the station - follow "Town Centre" signs.

Purchasing your ticket

You can buy tickets online - <https://www.gwr.com> and other sites and download them onto your phone or collect them at the station from the ticket machine. You can also buy most common tickets directly from the machine at the station using a credit or debit card. **If you cannot buy your ticket before you join the train at Melksham, you may join the train without and purchase from the Train Manager.** If in doubt, confirm with the train manager as you join

Some sample adult day return fares:

Melksham → Swindon £11.90 (£8.80 off peak)
 Melksham → Bristol £14.00 (£11.90 off peak^(*))
 Melksham → Salisbury £20.90 (£16.20 off peak)

Railcard and child discounts apply.

As we go to press in late August 2023, industrial action, staff shortages and other issues are resulting in some service cancellations. If your service is cancelled:

* **If you are travelling between SWINDON or CHIPPENHAM and TROWBRIDGE or WESTBURY** you may use services via Bath Spa (with a change there) even on a lower priced "via Melksham" ticket. If the "via Melksham" service is running normally, you may still travel on the extra services via Bath Spa but often the fare is higher.

* **If you are travelling to or from Melksham,** note that bus service x34 runs during the day on Monday to Saturday from Trinity Church (Trowbridge, near the station) to Melksham (Town Centre and Broughton Road) and Chippenham (Bus Station; early morning and late afternoon journeys serving the railway station). At the time of writing, these bus services do not accept train tickets. Buses run by Faresaver - currently £2 (£2.50 from November) fare cap.

* **Under most circumstances (not industrial action or extreme weather), the train operator - Great Western Railway - has an obligation to get you there.** This may be waiting for the next train, or if there is a long gap they may provide replacement road transport. Note that at short notice this may take some time to provide, and unless you see or hear announcements otherwise you will need to ask for it to be provided. Use the help point if you are at a station that is not staffed.

* **If you arrive at your final destination more than 15 minutes late due to issues with your trains, you may claim delay/repay.** This is limited to the initial cost of your ticket and does not cover consequential losses, so you are advised to travel in good time if headed for a job interview, airline flight or similar.
